

#### **OUTLINE OF SESSION COMMITTEES**

<u>CHRISTIAN EDUCATION: Eileen Tremblay and Gail Rhinehart:</u> This ministry is concerned with the Sunday School Program for the children of our church. They decide what curriculum will be used as well as the type of program will be planned for each calendar year.

**FINANCE & STEWARDSHIP:** Sue Butchinski and Scott Kramlich: This ministry's main function is to address any issues concerning the finances of the church and to develop stewardship programs when required.

<u>MEMBERSHIP, OUTREACH & MISSION: Eileen Tremblay: This ministry concerns itself with developing a mission plan for the church, instituting programs and informing the congregation of any special collections governed by the Lehigh Presbytery. They are also involved with home communion for our shut-ins as well as any outreach programs to those in our surrounding community.</u>

<u>PERSONNEL: John Hrizuk:</u> This ministry is responsible for maintaining open communication with all church employees, conducting interviews when hiring new employees and also conduction yearly reviews of all church employees. They recommend pay rates, increases in pay rates as well as handling any issues that may arise involving church employee relations.

<u>PROPERTY: Dave Sentiwany, John Faisetty and Sue Butchinski:</u> This ministry is responsible for the maintenance, up-keep and general inspections of the church and the surrounding church property. They schedule routine inspections for the heating & air conditioning, fire extinguishers, etc. They perform general maintenance (painting, light bulb replacement, carpentry, etc) to the church building. They deal with contractors getting estimates and follow thru with scheduled work to be done. This is a very hands on ministry.

<u>WORSHIP & MUSIC: Sally Heffner:</u> This ministry takes care of anything having to do with our church services. They set up/take down communion, change vestments, hang banners, plan special services, recommend dates/times for services. They coordinate music needs with minister.

**COMMUNICATION:** Tammy Seidick: This ministry is responsible for maintaining the church website (updating content) and Facebook pages with information about the activities within our church.

<u>FELLOWSHIP & GROUP LIFE:</u> Sue Butchinski, Sally Heffner, Joyce Wheeler: This ministry in responsible for planning any special functions held within the church including Fellowship after services, special dinners, refreshments for special meetings, refreshments for election day, etc.

**NOMINATING: John Hrizuk and Eileen Tremblay:** This ministry is responsible for nominating church members to serve as Elders & Deacons as well as auditors. The committee is comprised of representatives from all groups within the church.
