

The Per Capita Apportionment for 2023 is \$48 per member. Lehigh Presbytery receives \$35.75 to support and strengthen our local congregations. Synod of the Trinity receives \$2.40, they serve 16 Presbyteries across Pennsylvania and parts of West Virginia and the Office of the General Assembly of the PC USA receives \$9.85 to support Synods, Presbyteries and over 8900 congregations.
